

**Konstantina Zanou** is joining Columbia University in Fall 2016 as an Assistant Professor of Italian specializing in Mediterranean Studies in the Department of Italian. She is currently a fellow of the Institute of Advanced Studies of Paris, while she has previously held fellowships and taught at the University of Nicosia (Research Promotion Foundation of Cyprus), New York University (Fulbright), Centre for Advanced Studies Sofia Bulgaria, Queen Mary University of London (British School at Athens grant) and Université Paris-Est Créteil. Her publications include a co-edited volume on *Mediterranean Diasporas: Politics and Ideas in the Long Nineteenth Century* (Bloomsbury, 2015) and several articles on expatriate intellectuals and national consciousness in the post-Venetian Adriatic. Her book *Transnational Patriotism in the Mediterranean, 1800-1830: Stammering the Nation* is forthcoming with Oxford University Press.
